The Forde Grange Goat Dairy at Forde Abbey held its open day on Friday 12th September, with over one hundred people attending. Visitors were taken on a tour of what is now one of the largest goat dairies in the country and had the opportunity to watch the goats being milked in the new parlour – a wonder of new technology.

BCM acted for the estate and was heavily involved throughout the appraisal through to implementation in this major agricultural investment. The total investment exceeded £1 million and was a joint venture between the Forde Abbey Estate and the Frosts, a local farming family. This much sought after milk is taken by the Cornish Country Larder chain and the milk and a range of cheeses can be found on the major supermarket shelves of Waitrose, Sainsburys, Asda and Tesco.
